TURF NEWS

The conclusion to the 2018 season was one of the most trying experiences I have ever endured in 15 years of golf course maintenance in PEI. Starting after the Thanksgiving weekend, we experienced continuous days of rain, high winds and very few days where it was optimal to complete our fall maintenance practices efficiently let alone completion of late season projects around the properties. When weather cooperated soil conditions were saturated and turf conditions were tender allowing minimal equipment operation and landscape projects to be scrapped for the season. Our records have indicated a four week period from mid-October to early November consisting of eight inches of rainfall and numerous days of high wind speeds. There was a brief lapse allowing for some of the snow mould applications to take place before the snow fall started and continued for days on end with cold temperatures and winds. With lots of dedicated and determined turf crew staff as well as a top notch management/ownership team, willing to help in anyway, we were able to complete our much needed greens snow mould protection for the 2018 season. Thanks guys!

As we find ourselves in the midst of a cold 2019 winter, I have attached a link which will help explain how there are many factors which play a huge role in our turf health survival throughout these ever changing weather events. As we have done in the past, we as a turf maintenance team will continue to develop strategies to battle our Prince Edward Island climate. Our goal as always is to produce a golf experience for all of you to enjoy!
