A valid handicap is required for all leagues and events.

Turf News

A funny thing happens when your pour countless resources and man hours into a property and get just a slight break

from mother nature, it starts to show. The efforts of the grounds crew and property managers can often go unnoticed when the weather is not cooperating and now that it is I would be remiss not to mention their individual efforts.

Alan, Anthony, Des, Eric, Guy, Kevin, Leigh, Morgan, Mackenzie, Olivia, Phyllis, Rob C, and Roger each do a fantastic job and take pride in their work. If you see them out on the course take a moment to let them know, they deserve it. Last but not least long time Superintendent of Andersons Creek, Robert McGregor. His steadfast dedication to this property over the past decade has turned it into what it is today and should not go unrecognized. Thank you Robert.



Turning our focus to the golf course a noticeable change in the weather is showing out there on the course. The greens, tees, fairways and rough are responding favourably to fertilizer applications. Maintenance spends more time on mowers and blowers to keep up with the growth and excess clipping volume that comes with mowing lots of grass in wet conditions. I'd much rather be dealing with lots of mowing and clipping cleanup as opposed to no growth and nothing to clean up at this point in the season. I take this as a good sign. The tees are noticeably discoloured from an herbicide application aimed at reducing the amount of weeds in the tee decks. The weeds (broadleaf plantain, dandelions, clover) are not only unsightly but reduce the playing quality and overall experience of the golf course. They grow at different rates and have different colors. I am not a fan of them. The

difficult part of applying an herbicide to them is that at too low of a rate you don't get much accomplished and at too high of a rate you end up killing everything. Neither of these outcomes are acceptable or worth the effort.

I would say the rate of product that was applied was adequate in the sense that we did not kill the grass and on close inspection there is noticeable suppression of the weeds mentioned above. It's a slow process and there is no quick fix. The window for another application is narrowing because as the weather gets hotter the turf becomes more stressed and herbicide applications become more detrimental to the turf. You get more discoloration and set the growth of the turf back too much for comfort. We will bring the colour and vigor back to the tee decks with a combination of growth and water retention products before even thinking about another herbicide application this summer. If the temperatures stay down and we get good colour back we will go at them again, otherwise it will have to wait until the fall.



Thanks for thinking ahead and putting a ball mark tool in your pocket before teeing off. Thank you for fixing yours and your playing partners ball mark. It means a lot to us. Now let's go play some golf. - **Superintendent**, **Graham Wieja**

the competition is in two formats, first a "Skins Game" as well as a Chicago points competition. The Skins game is a "net Skins" and the Chicago game is similarly, a handicapped event. - All four par three holes are Closest To The Pin (KP) holes. At present, there is no cost for membership; There will be, typically, four steak barbecue nights each season. Each person is responsible for the cost of the barbecue and whatever else they order at the bar.

Each Wednesday evening the participants pay \$14.00 and these payments fund the Skins, Chicago and KP competitions.

Thursday Mens

The "Thursday Group Mens League" will begin play this year on May 9th. They presently have four tee times beginning at 9:10 AM.
