Club Updates

TURF NEWS

One month ago I wrote that the ideal forecast going forward for the remainder of April was lots of sun, high winds, and minimal precipitation to allow the course to dry up and get the grass growing. Well... it has been pretty windy. As for the sun and minimal precipitation we did not get as lucky. Constant rain showers and cold weather has taken its toll on the course. The greens remain very soft. Soft greens hinder the grounds crew's ability to perform daily maintenance to the greens such as mowing and rolling. Anyone who has played the course has surely noticed sinkholes on the greens, bumpy putting surfaces, and slow greens speeds.

The sink holes, while relatively small, are a nuisance and can often affect play. If you look closely at their location on the green they are all located in the same area that the putting greens drainage system is located. If I had to guess I would say intense frost heaves are causing the drain tile below the green to shift up and down pushing the soil on top of it in any direction it can go. This heaving damages the integrity of the soil profile and the end result after snowmelt and substantial rainfall are sinkholes. The damages are compounded by putting machinery on the greens before they are completely firm. We are working our way around the greens taking care of this issue as quickly as we can. If you happen to come across a sinkhole please avoid walking near them.

Spring is an interesting time of year for golf course maintenance. Some grass is growing in certain areas, a lot of grass isn't growing anywhere. The turf crew is striving to provide a great product with consistent playing surfaces. The funny thing about trying to provide consistency at this time of year is the fact that nearly every hole requires completely different inputs to achieve this. It is because of this that you will see some areas tarped, some areas freshly aerated, some areas topdressed and seeded. Some areas we have to walk mow, others can be mowed with a ride on mower. It's a continual cat and mouse game trying to encourage growth in areas of need and slow down areas that are growing too quickly.

I've heard that patience is a virtue. Truer words couldn't be spoken about the great golfers of PEI. The heat will come. The grass will grow. And the squares on the scorecards will become circles. All in good time.

New members are welcome. Golfers typically play their own ball and the competition is in two formats, first a "Skins Game" as well as a Chicago points competition. The Skins game is a "net Skins" and the Chicago game is similarly, a handicapped event. - All four par three holes are Closest To The Pin (KP) holes. At present, there is no cost for membership; There will be, typically, four steak barbecue nights each season. Each person is responsible for the cost of the barbecue and whatever else they order at the bar.

Each Wednesday evening the participants pay \$14.00 and these payments fund the Skins, Chicago and KP competitions.

Thursday Mens - Ongoing

The "Thursday Group Mens League" will begin play this year on May 9th. They presently have four tee times beginning at 9:10 AM. In order to play with this group, one must have a valid Golf Canada Handicap. Players will play from the tees where they have established their handicaps and only 70% of their handicaps will be used. Tips for playing golf in the wind

Don't view the wind as a bad thing. You have to accept that it's part of the game. The wind is actually great because you get to practice being creative with your shots.

Swing easy. Many people believe that you need to swing harder in order to beat the windy conditions, but this is wrong! The harder you hit, the more backspin. Try swinging at about 70% – 80%. It'll help your shot go lower and avoid the dreadful backspin that could make your ball land short.

Don't lean into the wind during your swing. Leaning in during your swing will create a steep swing path, which isn't good because having an open club face isn't ideal. Squat a bit lower for stability and resist the urge to fight the wind.

Keep the ball's flight path low. The higher the ball goes, the more of a chance the wind is going to affect your ball. Play the ball about an inch back from normal in your stance and make and focus on sweeping the ball forward.

Playing a crosswind from the tee. Set up your ball on the side of the tee box opposite from where the wind is blowing. This will maximize the amount of room you have to effectively play the wind.
