We are very excited Andersons Creek will be open for play, tomorrow, May 14th! We cannot wait to welcome our members back but will have strict COVID-19 procedures in place. All of our COVID-19 policies can be found on our website at andersonscreek.com/policies and on the following page.

We will be combining the AC, GG, and FH memberships for this season. Food & Beverage

The Hub will be operating with a limited menu until we are given the go ahead from the Public Health Office regarding additional food service.

We're currently offering sandwiches, chips, chocolate bars, beer, coolers, spirits, non-alcoholic beverages, coffee, and tea.

During your round, we are asking that people call their orders in to the Pro Shop and pick them up through 9. If you want to order something prior to your round, just touch base with the Pro Shop as you check-in!



COVID-19 POLICIES

Booking

- Tee times will only be made online or over the phone. We are asking that everyone prepay or at minimum sign up for their memberships prior to showing up for their first tee time. This can be done over the phone or on our website. We are trying to limit cash transactions so where possible please pay with debit or credit.
- Groups will consist of no more than 4 people.
 Physical distancing must be observed at all times, with a minimum of two metres between players.
- All players MUST have a tee time. No walk-ons will be permitted.

Arrival

- Groups will be asked to wait to be called to first tee to start. Please do not show up more than 20 minutes prior to your tee time.
- Members and guests will be asked to leave immediately after their round to avoid gathering.

On-Course

- Always maintain physical distancing (2 meters or 6 feet apart)
- Do not touch anything that does not belong to you
- Maintain pace of play. Your round should not take any longer than 4 hours. Please do not play through players in front of you.
- Rakes, ball washers, benches, and on-course garbage cans have been removed from the course. When you finish your round, please dispose of your garbage in the can at the cart return.

Clubhouse

- The washrooms in the clubhouse will be open for member use. We are allowing one person in the washroom at a time.
- All indoor food, beverage and retail service is suspended, except curbside pick-up or delivery.
- Players are encouraged to call ahead to place orders and coordinate pick-up.

Practice Area

- Practice range will not be open until May 22nd at the earliest.
- These guidelines will be adjusted as notified by the Public Health Office.

Golf Carts & Push Carts

- Golf cart and pull cart rentals are permitted and will be cleaned and sanitized between uses.
- Limit of one person per golf cart, unless the occupants reside in the same household.
- Golf carts are on a first come, first serve basis.
 Carts for members are now \$25 (tax included) for a single rider and \$17 (tax included) if sharing with a member of your household.
 The Pro Shop does have a 10 cart punch card for sale that is \$150 (tax included).

Post Round

 Please leave immediately following your round. Do not loiter around the clubhouse or in the parking lot.

Staff will ask any player/guest to leave the property if they witness any of the safety protocols being ignored.

TURF NEWS

Andersons Creek Golf Club overwintered well with less winter damage than was anticipated! Permanent snow and ice cover far exceeded the 90 day threshold in a lot of areas of the course and the turfgrass underneath is alive and well for the most part. It is not actively growing yet in a lot of areas as soil and air temperatures remain low.

The ground didn't seem to freeze thoroughly going into the winter and I have observed very little heaving in the soil from the frost as compared to the past few years. This is good news as we battled sinkholes and sunken drain lines well into the summer last year. There was a lot of snow mold formed underneath the snow cover across the golf course that is unsightly and will take some growth and mowing to recuperate the lost turf.

Snow mold is an interesting turfgrass disease because it can occur whether snow is present or not and is a concern for about 7 months a year. It often develops in small patches but given enough infection the patches can coalesce to create a substantial amount of turf loss. The pictures below can illustrate it better than I can explain it as the fairway and green were sprayed to prevent the pathogen that causes snow mould and the surrounding rough wasn't.





Other areas of turf were damaged this year by voles. Vole damage is a nuisance but not nearly as detrimental as winterkill.

I find a lot of regrowth occurs if you leave the turned up dead grass where it is until the shoots that come up underneath are strong enough to survive the elements. Then discard the dead grass and push the area along with some fertilizer later in the year when growth is

strong.



I'm really excited to get this season underway. There are going to be a lot of changes and challenges to deal with. Course set-up, and the overall way the game is played is going to feel a little different. If there is one thing inherent in the game of golf it is change. There are several examples; from the recent rule changes, technology and fashion, parity of winning on the PGA tour, to the golf course itself on a day to day basis and over a long period of time. Some changes the game of golf have seen have been naturally occurring and some have been forced. I feel like this change we're about to deal with is kind of both. Looking forward to seeing some socially distanced darts being thrown out there.


